The TEIs are required to re-design/update their websites within period of two months from the date of publication of the Public Notice on the NCTE website for which they have to use the attached Template.

As per the MoU between the QCI and NCTE, a TEI shall pay fee of Rs. 3,150/- per year to the QCI in connection with E-monitoring of its website. The TEI is required to pay the fee on-line to QCI within one month from the date of publication of the Notice on the website of NCTE.
